

ORDINANCE NO. 4

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CERTAIN ACTIONS TO BE PUBLIC NUISANCES.

The Township of Hematite Ordains:

SECTION 1: It shall be considered a public nuisance for any person to accumulate or permit to accumulate in any yard, alley, vacant lot or other spaces in the Township of Hematite of any lumber, boxes, barrels, bricks, stones, scrap materials, motor vehicle bodies or parts, or similar materials or rubbish or any other articles of junk except as may be necessary and incidental to construction work or the normal course of business or trade conducted on said premises.

SECTION 2: Every act, thing, devise or condition which is forbidden by this Ordinance shall be deemed to be a public nuisance. In addition, any act, thing, condition, land, building or premises which annoys, injures or endangers the public health, safety, comfort, offends public decency, or in any way renders the public insecure in life or property is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

SECTION 3: Any person who violates or fails to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the county jail not to exceed 90 days, or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court. In the event that the fine is imposed, the Court shall have power to commit the violator to the county jail until such time as the fine is paid, not to exceed, however, 90 days from the date of commitment.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall become effective 30 days after publication.
