There is a potential for a northbound and southbound detour through Amasa when culverts are to be repaired, with plans to begin in 2027. Road Commission got approved for FEMA relief money to start repair on Park City bridge, Parks Farm bridge, and Maki bridge. Additional discussion had about pulling up the rails in town. More info will be coming as Toivonen gets more updates.

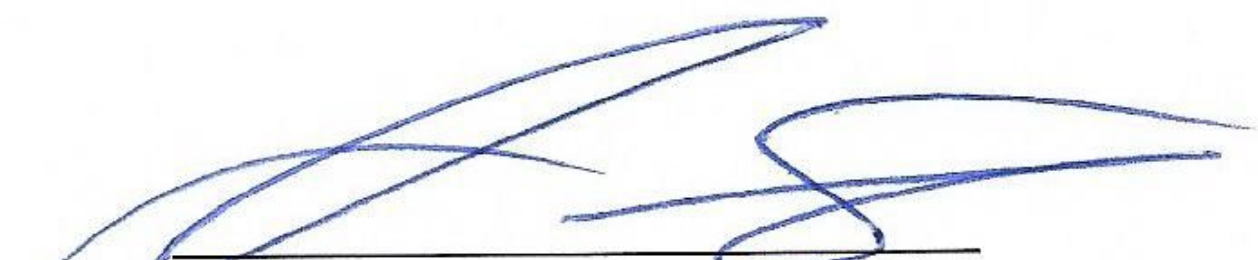

TREASURER/CLERK REPORT: **A)** Tax bills have been mailed out, all expenses standard this month.

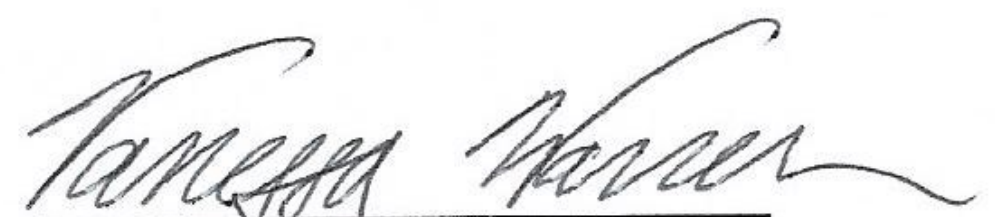
